

**ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS
FOR
MAIL-IN RE-VOTING DUE TO MISSING
MAIL-IN REGISTRATION FORMS AND BALLOTS
for CC2009 Delegate Election in Maryland**

Your “Registration Form for Mail-In Re-voting” AND your re-voted Maryland Ballot must be received by midnight, Thursday, October 29th, 2009, by one of two methods described below. Please note that the “Registration Form for Mail-In Re-voting” is self-authenticating and does NOT need to be notarized as was previously required.

The two methods include:

1. Faxing both forms to 1-888-858-6923 (toll-free number)

Faxing is either free if you have fax access, or very inexpensive if you don't have access to a fax and you go to a Fedex-Kinkos or grocery store to fax; however, it will compromise a secret ballot since both the Registration Form AND the ballot are faxed together.

2. Sending via an Overnight Courier (such as FedEx, UPS, USPS) to:

Attorney David Rogers is a longtime fair elections advocate, a VoteRescue supporter, and specializes in election integrity cases.

By putting your Registration Form in one envelope marked “Registration”, and your ballot in another envelope marked “Ballot”, and placing both envelopes in a larger envelope which is delivered overnight, you can maintain the privacy of your ballot. The cost involved will be that of an overnight delivery. (Due to the time constraints, we do not recommend sending through regular mail.)

All votes will be counted by VoteRescue in accordance with the Election Handbook and Addendum No. 1 and the results will be sent to CC2009 Headquarters no later than 9 pm Friday, October 30th for posting.
